



Lower Platte Archery Club Charter

The Lower Platte Archery Club was formed to promote the sport of archery in Gretna and the surrounding areas. The mission of the Lower Platte Archery Club is to introduce as many youth and adults as possible to the enjoyment and sport of archery through league shooting. The club's existence will be perpetual. Should at any time the club dissolve, any equipment or money held by the club will be turned over to the Nebraska Game & Parks Commission. Officers elected annually at the winter meeting will be a President, Statistician, and Secretary/Treasurer. These officers may call a membership meeting whenever need arises. Decisions regarding dues, shooting fees and other matters will be made by majority vote of the members present at club meetings. Members will consist of the people participating in the summer and winter leagues. All monies will be held in a non-interest bearing account at American National Bank until disbursements need to be made. As this is a non-profit club revenues and expenses should zero each other out each year. Home range for the summer league will be the Larry Elston Archery Range at Schramm Park with approval of the Nebraska Game & Parks Commission. Home range for the winter league will be the Old Gretna Co-op building, 820 Burns Street, Gretna, NE.
